DIRECTIONS TO “MULLOON CREEK NATURAL FARMS”

From Canberra / Bungendore

- Drive to Bungendore
- Continue through Bungendore (on the Kings Highway towards Braidwood & Bateman’s Bay)
- Look at speedo reading at 100 km per hour sign on Braidwood side of Bungendore
- Continue for approx 11kms. You will be traveling up a hill (The Great Dividing Range). There is an overtaking lane, which finishes just before the top of the hill – a right hand turning lane is immediately after the end of the overtaking lane. Take this right turn in to the farm.
- There is also a finger sign, on the right hand side of the road, pointing right. The sign says “Mulloon Creek Natural Farms” –“The Home Farm”.

From Sydney / Goulburn / Braidwood

- From Sydney, head towards Canberra.
- Take the first exit into Goulburn (about 2 hours from Sydney).
- Turn left at first set of traffic lights. Follow for a couple of kilometers past railway station on the left and Woolworths on the right.
- Turn left over the railway line at signs to Braidwood.
- Go on Braidwood Road, straight through Lake Bathurst and Tarago (do NOT turn right to “Bungendore” in Tarago).
- After about 30 minutes from Goulburn, when you come to a T-junction where you can turn left to Braidwood or right to Canberra, take the right turn.
- After a few kilometers you cross The Mulloon Creek itself and soon start climbing up the Great Dividing Range.
- After another 4 kilometers or so you will see signs with a black cross on a yellow background, with a picture of a truck underneath. Soon after that there is a finger sign on a post on the left saying “Mulloon Creek Natural Farms”. Turn left.

Once on the farm

- Go over front grid. Follow through a couple of kilometers of bush. This opens up into a valley.
- Go past the cattle yards and Manager’s house. Keep going until you pass a large dam on the right (it’s so beautiful when it is full!).
- Shortly after is a left turn ... you will see the barn (venue) and a lagoon on the right, continue along until you come to the parking area at the stables (total distance from front grid to the stables is nearly 6 km’s)
